

An organizational meeting was held Oct 24, at Lynwood Park in Bailey. Of great interest was the meeting between CDOT and Zdenko Novkovic, Susan Lambert and the Kulenberg's. The group was impressed with how CDOT was willing to work with us.

- 🚧 They discussed the location of the new speed limit sign for the Coney Island area.
- 🚧 Placement of "Food, Gas, Lodging, Historic Site" signage.
- 🚧 Planned 285 improvements.
- 🚧 Distributed CDOT drawings of proposed improvements.

Susan and Zdenko had met with the TSR group, a firm that is comprised of employees who are Planning and Design, Development Management, Natural Resource, GIS, CAD, and Software Engineering experts. They have been involved in other projects in the county and were familiar with the area. They gave Susan and Z a proposal for Bailey Main Street design and visualization services, which the members will look over and comment at the next meeting.

- 🔥 Geneva Basin, as always, is of interest as a ski, cross country ski, tubing, snowshoe, etc. area. If there were interest in the economic community, our role would be of support.
- 🔥 Renovation of downtown Bailey. We had a clean up day and have many plans we would like to implement. Kate, Linda, Lyn and Nicki will spearhead this committee.
- 🔥 Bailey incorporation. It's been talked about, Z and Art Hall will look into what exactly is needed to make this happen.
- 🔥 Keeping the Bailey business owners apprised of what we are doing. Linda, Lyn and Z will do their best to keep communication open.
- 🔥 Keeping the public aware of what we are doing. Mary is putting out to the public a call for Logo designs, and will develop marketing strategies.
- 🔥 Fund raising, if anyone has any ideas we can implement, please let us know. We have the manpower and desire.
- 🔥 A vision and mission statement is needed; Jerry has volunteered to formulate one.
